JULY 2013

The Consumer Price Index registered a decrease of 0.6 percent for the month of July 2013. The "All Items" index stood at 107.0 in comparison to 107.6 for the month of June 2013. The "point-to-point" inflation rate was recorded as negative 0.3 percent.

Two (2) groups recorded decreases during the month: "Communication" (7.2 percent) and "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.1 percent). Seven (7) groups recorded increases during the month: "Transport" (1.7 percent), "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" (0.4 percent), "Recreation & Culture" (0.3 percent), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.2 percent), "Clothing & Footwear" (0.1 percent), "Health" (0.1 percent) and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" (0.1 percent). Three (3) groups remained unchanged: "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance", "Education", "Health" and "Restaurants & Hotels"

The 7.2 percent decline in the "Communication" group index was a result of a 23.7 percent reduction on average in telephone rates; mobile to mobile and mobile to fixed line.

The "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" group index declined by 0.1 percent as a result of a 3.9 percent decrease in the cost of electricity. The decrease in the price of electricity was due to a fall in the fuel surcharge rate from 51.41 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of June, to 50.84 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of July 2013.

'Transport" group index increased by 1.7 percent due mainly to a higher prices in passenger air fare from St. Vincent and the Grenadines to several destinations; namely New York (63.1 percent), Toronto (58.1 percent), London (15.0 percent), Trinidad and Tobago (5.0 percent) and Barbados (0.8 percent).

The group index for "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco and Narcotics" increased by 0.1 percent due mainly to increase in the price of stout (5.4 percent) and rum - imported (3.7 percent).

The group index "Food & Non –Alcoholic Beverages" increased by 0.2 percent, attributed mainly to an increase in the price of a number of items; fish - fresh jacks (12.5 percent), fish - fresh robin (12.5 percent), cornflakes (5.6 percent), other cereal (4.2 percent), evaporated milk (3.0 percent), luncheon meat - pork (2.9 percent) and powdered milk - full cream (2.2 percent).

"Clothing & Footwear" group index recorded an increase of 0.1 percent as a result of a higher price for men's tie. The 0.1 percent increase for the group index "Health" was attributed mainly to an increase in the price of drugs for cancer (16.7 percent). The "Miscellaneous Goods and Services" group index registered an increase of 0.1 percent contributed by increases in the price for shampoo (4.9 percent) and conditioner (4.9 percent).


