

JUNE 2012

The Consumer Price Index registered a decrease of 0.1 percent for the month of June 2012. The "All Items" index stood at 106.6 compared with 106.7 recorded in May 2012. The "point-to-point" inflation rate was recorded as 2.8 percent.

Four (4) groups recorded increases during the month: "Clothing and Footwear" (0.5 percent), "Food and Non-Alcoholic Beverages" (0.5 percent), "Transport" (0.4 percent), "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" (0.1 percent). Two (2) groups recorded a decrease: "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" (0.8 percent), "Recreation and Culture" (0.6 percent). Six (6) groups remained unchanged: "Alcoholic Beverages, Tobacco & Narcotics", "Health", "Communication, "Education", "Restaurants and Hotels" and "Miscellaneous Goods and Services".

The group index for "Clothing and Footwear" increased by 0.5 percent due to an increase in the prices of cotton brief, size medium (100.0 percent) and polyester tie (25.0 percent).

The "Food and Non-alcoholic Beverages" group index recorded a 0.5 percent increase as a result of increase prices for several food items namely; yeast – instant (39.6 percent), powdered milk - skimmed (22.9 percent), ice cream (15.2 percent), peanut butter (8.9 percent), onions (7.3 percent), mutton (2.3 percent), condense milk (1.3 percent), chicken - whole leg (1.1 percent) and chicken - wings (1.0 percent).

The 0.4 percent increase in the index for "Transport" resulted from higher prices for vehicle brake shoes (9.1 percent), passenger transport by air: St. Vincent to Toronto (26.4 percent) and St. Vincent to New York (11.5 percent).

The "Furnishings, Household Equipment and Household Maintenance" group index increased by 0.1 percent as a result of increase in the price of washing powder (2.6 percent), toilet paper (2.2 percent) and air freshener (1.1 percent).

The "Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels" group index decreased by 0.8 percent which was attributed mainly to a 4.3 percent decrease in the cost of electricity. This decrease was due to a lower fuel surcharge rate of 52.7 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of June, compared to 57.3 cents per kilowatt hour for the month of May. The 0.6 percent decrease in the group index "Recreation and Culture" is due mainly to a decrease in the price of carnival costumes (16.7 percent).


